# Recently Completed Fundraising Project

Total Amount Needed: \$945.44

### Total Raised \$4,020 (\$2,426 + 56,000 THB)

When we asked for support replacing the worn-out rugs in our Buddha Room, donations came pouring in. Our cozy new rugs provide warmth and cushioning for monks, nuns, and temple visitors while helping reduce our heating bills.

Thank you all for helping us exceed our fundraising goals. Excess funds are being allocated to other capital projects, including fixing our damaged pipes.

Security Cameras & Lights
Total Amount Needed: \$1,949.61

#### Total Raised \$2,185 (\$1,701 + 17,000 THB)

Cameras have already been installed in the building in order to increase monitoring, protection, and safety for our monks, nuns, and members.

# Replacing Damaged Entryways

During recent rain storms the ceiling of the temple's classrooms began to leak. We traced the issue to our front stairs, finding dry rot in the wood that supports the stairs and entryway. Given the danger these structural issues present, we had no choice but to remove and replace the pillars and stairs. # **Fixing Damaged Pipes**

Help to free the temple from obstruction:

Goal: \$6,200

Total received so far: \$3,309.95 (allocated from carpets and security camera fundraisers)

Amount left to raise: \$2,890.05

For years, the temple has had difficulty with backups in the sewage system due to roots pushing against outdoor pipes.

Though in the past, the city has been able to help flush the pipes, blockages have become so severe that we were forced to replace the pipes in order to prevent further clogging and dirty water leaking onto the sidewalk. Help cover the cost of these plumbing repairs and allow good merit to flow through your life as easily as flowing water and for bad things to flow away from you without obstruction.
