




Greetings, San Fran Dhammaram Community Members!

San Fran Dhammaram Temple's Fundraisers




April 3 Birthday Fundraiser



Recently, the kuti, a small hut or lodging where a monk lives during Dhamma practice at the Khippapañño Dhamma Practice Center in Trang, Thailand, has been damaged due to a termite infestation. The center has a total of 10 kuti made out of wood, with 4 kuti already damaged. The Khippapañño Dhamma Practice Center plans to fix them soon. The estimated cost for each kuti is \$2,754, with an approximate total cost of \$11,017.




Summer Semester Enrollment
